7.4. Safety:

Below is a brief summary of how to spectate safely. If the drivers know this is being implemented then there will be more excitement to see as the drivers will be able to drive faster.

Don't:

- Stand on the track
- Stand below the level of the track
- Stand in front of arrows or signs
- Stand in prohibited areas
- Stand or sit on or near log piles, walls or fences
- Sit close to the edge of the track
- Block escape routes
- Be distracted
- Play games with your safety or that of the drivers
- Remove stage signs or arrows
- Be the one to stop the stage

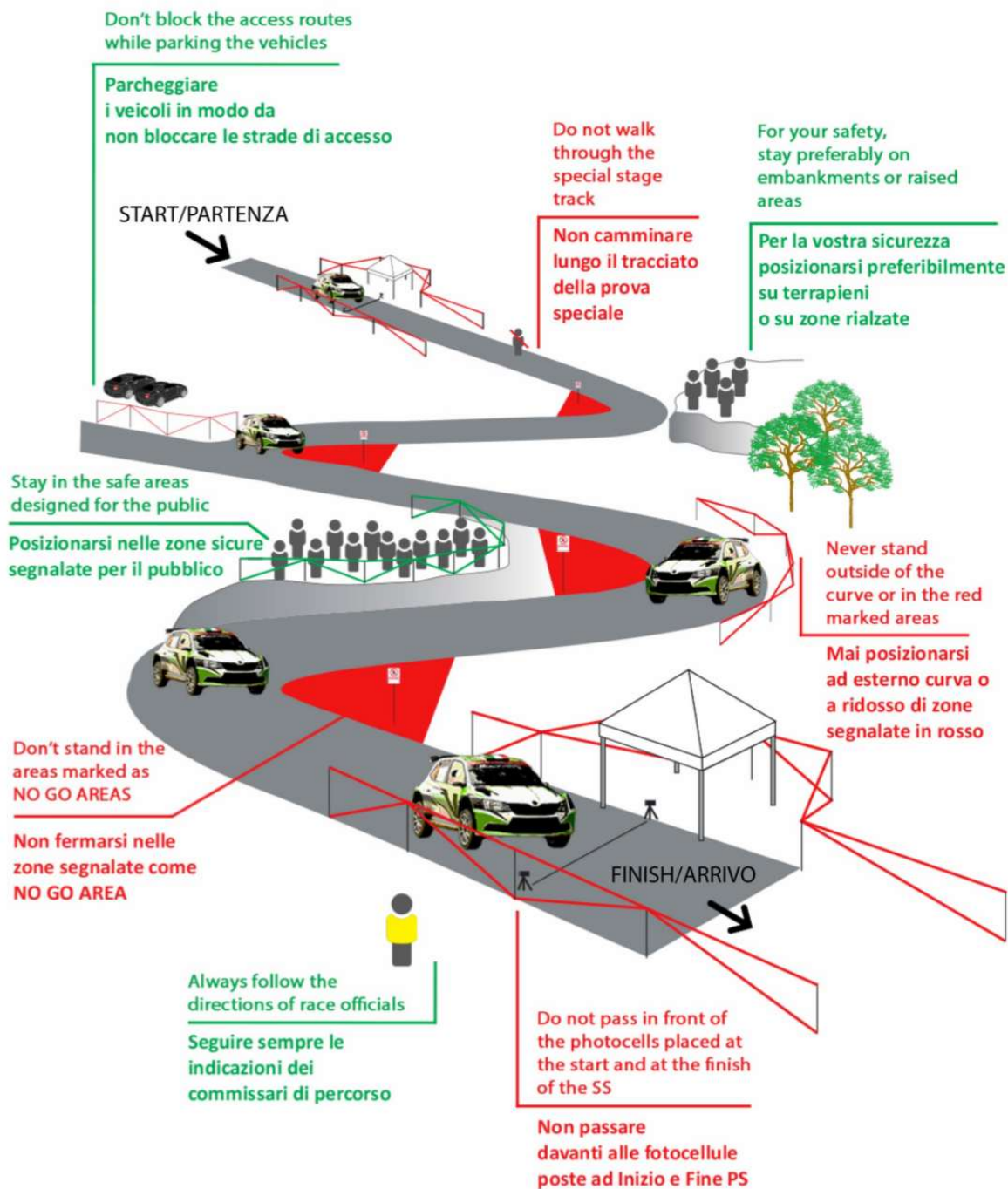
Always:

- Expect the unexpected
- Stay behind the safety tape or barriers
- Listen for approaching cars
- Remain alert
- Leave yourself room to move quickly
- Plan your own escape routes
- Try to keep behind something solid
- Keep children under supervision
- Keep dogs on a lead
- Do as the marshal's ask
- Help the marshal's to run a safe stage
