

MEDIA OPERATORS | HOW IT WORKS

To apply for press accreditation, please follow the procedure as outlined on the www.rallydiromacapitale.it/media website.

THE BRACELETS

When collecting your press kit, you will receive a yellow bracelet which you must keep for the duration of the event, indicating your health clearance.

Colleagues who can enter the press room (25 places selected by the organiser in coordination with Eurosport Events and ACI Sport) will receive a specific green bracelet.

STAGES

Access to the special stages will only be allowed in the designated zones. These zones, the safety regulations and all instructions of the officials must be respected at all times.

TABARDS


In order to ensure that the MEDIA operators are recognisable at all times during the race, each participant

will be given an identification waistcoat which must be worn at all times in the special stage, start and finish

and in the media zones to facilitate the recognition of the operators on duty.

As they are disposable, no deposit will be required for the use of the bibs, which are not to be returned.

PRE-EVENT PRESS CONFERENCES

It will be held by the pool at the Hotel Fiuggi Terme Resort & Spa - Via Capo i Prati, 9 - Fiuggi Terme. All accredited people can participate. The Press Conference will take place at

14:00 on Friday July 23rd with the presence of a selected list of drivers (to be announced at a later date).

POST EVENT PRESS CONFERENCES

The final press conference will be held following the podium ceremony on Sunday 26 July, directly on the finish line. All accredited persons may attend. The top three drivers of the event will participate.

START AND FINISH CEREMONIES

The MEDIA pass does not allow access to the Press Room. Colleagues who will have access to the press room will be selected by the organiser and Eurosport Events and will receive a dedicated communication.

PRESS ROOM

The MEDIA pass does not allow access to the Press Room. Colleagues who will have access to the press room will be selected by the organiser and Eurosport Events and will receive a dedicated communication.

SERVICE PARK

The Service Park will be in HDA and therefore not accessible to MEDIA. Those who will have this necessity will have to evodenzio it on the form of request for press accreditation and it will be required the presentation of a molecular Covid-19 PCR test at the time of withdrawal accreditation or Green Pass certification issued with both doses of vaccine carried out or certified recovery from Covid-19. In case of a PCR test this must be done no later than 96 hours before collecting the accreditation.

REGROUPING (MEDIA ZONE)

The tidy-up area preceding each Service Park will be open to media accredited drivers only. Inside the regrouping it will be compulsory to work with the mask, always respecting the social distancing and with interview instruments that allow the safety distance from the drivers (at least 1mt).

For those who do not comply with these provisions the accreditation will be revoked immediately.

Always respect the 3 rules

1. wash your hands often with soap or disinfectant gel
2. keep your mask on in all areas of the rally (HQ, Service Park, Regrouping, Media Zones)
3. avoid creating crowds

Tevere is the river that flows along the capital of Italy. It is the only one city in the world that has in its territory an overall State: the Vatican.

6.3. Fiuggi

Fiuggi is a comune (municipality) in the province of Frosinone in the region of Lazio in central Italy. The town of Fiuggi became famous for its Acqua di Fiuggi (Fiuggi Water) which flows from its natural springs and mountains. The water has been used in Italy since as early as the 14th century and is famous for its natural healing properties.

Fiuggi is a divided into two parts, the upper and lower. The area where the springs are located is called new Fiuggi, or Fiuggi Fonte at the base of the hill (it was developed during the Middle Ages so it is not all that new). The upper part, or old Fiuggi, is 760 metres (2,500 ft) above sea level. The natives call it "Fiuggi Città". Fiuggi Città is a medieval fortified village, which was around even before Roman times.

6.5. Safety:

Below is a brief summary of how to spectate safely. If the drivers know this is being implemented then there will be more excitement to see as the drivers will be able to drive faster.

Don't:

- Stand on the track
- Stand below the level of the track
- Stand in front of arrows or signs
- Stand in prohibited areas
- Stand or sit on or near log piles, walls or fences
- Sit close to the edge of the track
- Block escape routes
- Be distracted
- Play games with your safety or that of the drivers
- Remove stage signs or arrows
- Be the one to stop the stage

Always:

- Expect the unexpected
- Stay behind the safety tape or barriers
- Listen for approaching cars
- Remain alert
- Leave yourself room to move quickly
- Plan your own escape routes
- Try to keep behind something solid
- Keep children under supervision
- Keep dogs on a lead
- Do as the marshal's ask
- Help the marshal's to run a safe stage

- Others around you
- The stage you are spectating at
- Rallying
- Motorsport
- The unexpected can happen
- If you ignore the marshal's instructions the stage will be stopped
