We at Rally di Roma recognize that It is important for motorsport events to reduce their environmental.

We have decided that our goal should be that Rally di Roma as a motorsport events should serve as a platform to raise awareness about environmental issues and promote sustainable practices. By demonstrating a commitment to reducing our environmental impact and promoting sustainable practices, Rally di Roma can inspire attendees and other organizations to adopt similar practices.

Furthermore, with growing public concern about the environment and climate change, we have a responsibility to minimize their environmental impact and demonstrate a commitment to sustainability. By taking steps to reduce our environmental impact, rally di Roma can enhance his reputation, attract more environmentally conscious attendees, and contribute to a more sustainable future.

- o Minimize and, wherever possible, avoid waste generation, promoting reduction, reuse and recycling management priorities.
- o When it is not possible to reduce the generation of waste, disseminate to all stakeholders of the event the implementation of the selective collection, through the correct disposal of waste for subsequent collection and proper disposal of waste at all places of passage of the event.
- o To set-up in the Service Park a recycling area of compulsory use by all teams, in order to place all generated polluting substances in adequate containers.
- o To set-up in the Special Stages a recycling area in order to place all generated polluting substances in adequate containers.
- o To raise awareness among spectators attending the special stages about the need to reduce environment.



o To remove all single-use plastic cups from the catering in the Service Park, making it compulsory to use paper ones.

o To remove all single-use plastic bottles from end of stage making compulsory the use of FIUGGI Paper bottle.

o To reduce vehicle travels by the organisation as much as possible, and to promote the use of hybrid (fuel/CNG) and electric vehicles, optimising the use of shared vehicles.

Keep an eye out for our sustainable initiatives on event, and please ensure that you help us to achieve our goals by disposing of your waste in the correct place (compostables, recyclables or general waste), taking any rubbish with you when spectating on stages.
