

COVID-19 PROTOCOL

MEDIA | RALLY DI ROMA CAPITALE 2020

MEDIA OPERATORS | HOW IT WORKS

Each accredited person, depending on the accreditation they have requested, has received several emails containing pass codes and health statements.

These documents must be printed and taken with you during the competition. Staff in charge will scan the codes for access to each work area (special stages, regrouping, etc.) in specific triage areas at the entrance to each area. Without these codes it will not be possible to enter the various zones.

THE BRACELETS

When you pick up the MEDIA kit, after checking that all health statements have been correctly signed, you will receive a green bracelet that you must keep for the duration of the event that will indicate your health status.

Colleagues who can enter the press room (20 places selected by the organiser in coordination with Eurosport Events and ACI Sport) will receive a specific bracelet.

STAGES


No spectators will be present at the special stages. Access to the special stages will be allowed only in the areas provided (maps are available in the Motorsport-Pass area dedicated to MEDIA (<https://www.motorsport-pass.com/prodotto/rrc-MEDIA/>)) to which you have had access to request your pass. Always respect these zones. You will not be allowed to move outside them.

TABARDS

In order to ensure that MEDIA operators are recognisable at all times during the competition, everyone will be given a recognition tabard which must be worn at all times, not just in special stages. This is for both photographers and all MEDIA operators (including journalists, press officers, etc.). Since they are disposable, no deposit will be required for the use of the tabards, which must not be returned.

*The CEREMONIES TABARD must be worn on top of any other TABARD at the time of its use.

MEDIA KIT COLLECTION

The MEDIA kit will be collected outside the Hotel Fiuggi Terme Resort & Spa - Via Capo i Prati, 9 - Fiuggi Terme on Thursday July 23rd.

In compliance with the social distance and the provisions of the Covid-19 regulations, the times to collect the printing kit will be from 7:00 to 12:00 and from 14:00 to 18:00. The use of the mask is compulsory.


If you are not available to pick up the MEDIA kit on Thursday 23rd, please inform press@rallydiromacapitale.it as soon as possible so that another time can be arranged.

To pick up the MEDIA kit you will need to present yourself with all the passes you received by e-mail (those with bar codes) filled in and signed in the self-declaration part. These documents will be verified but then they will be immediately returned to you for access to the various areas.

PRE-EVENT PRESS CONFERENCES

There will be two, on Friday July 24th, one for the Rally Stars Roma Capitale (WRC cars) and one for the Rally di Roma Capitale (ERC, CIR). They will be held by the pool at the Hotel Fiuggi Terme Resort & Spa - Via Capo i Prati, 9 - Fiuggi Terme. Journalists will be on one side, drivers on the other. All accredited media will be able to participate.

At 13:00 will be held the press conference Rally di Roma Capitale. Guests will be Craig Breen, Andrea Crugnola, Giandomenico Basso, Oliver Solberg, Adrien Fourmaux and Rachele Somaschini.

At 14:00 will be held the press conference Rally Stars Roma Capitale. Dani Sordo, Pierre-Louis Loubet and "Pedro" will be guests.

The press conferences will also be broadcast in live streaming on the Facebook page <https://www.facebook.com/RallydiRomaCapitale>.

POST EVENT PRESS CONFERENCES

There will be two, on Sunday July 26th, one for the Rally Stars Roma Capitale (WRC cars) and one for the Rally di Roma Capitale (ERC, CIR). They will be held in Fiuggi, on the arrival platform.

Only those accredited with S/F CEREMONY tabard will be able to participate.

At 17:40, following the award ceremony, the final press conference (with the first three classified) of the Rally Stars Roma Capitale will take place.

At 18:30, following the prize-giving ceremony, the final press conference (with the first three classified) of the Rally di Roma Capitale will take place.

The press conferences will also be broadcast in live streaming on the Facebook page <https://www.facebook.com/RallydiRomaCapitale>.

START AND FINISH CEREMONIES

Both ceremonies will take place in delimited places included in the Covid-19 plan of the race.

For this reason, access will be limited to a certain number of people and this will also limit access by the MEDIA.

The organiser, in collaboration with Eurosport Events, will select the accredited people who will be able to access the start and finish ceremonies, who will receive a blue bib (tabard) that will allow access.

STAGES END (STOP CONTROL)

All accredited operators (journalists, photos, videos) will not be allowed to work at the STOP controls of the stages. In addition to the Eurosport and ACI Sport crews, only some official MEDIA operators of the organization will be allowed to work at the end of the stages and will be notified by a dedicated email.

PRESS ROOM


The MEDIA pass does not allow access to the Press Room. Colleagues who will have access to the Press Room will be selected by the organiser and Eurosport Events and will receive a dedicated communication.

SERVICE PARK

The MEDIA pass does not allow access to the Service Park, but only to the MEDIA zones in special trial and regrouping (MEDIA zones).

REGROUPING (MEDIA ZONE)

The regrouping that will precede each Service Park will be allowed only to MEDIA accredited people. Mechanics, engineers and team members will not have access. It will therefore be a space for the exclusive use of journalists and operators for interviews.

The duration of the regrouping has been kept long in order to allow the work of everyone without gatherings or crowds near the drivers. The Eurosport and ACI Sport teams will take precedence over the other accredited teams.

Inside the regrouping it will be compulsory to work with the mask, always respecting the social distance and with interview instruments that allow a safe distance from the drivers (at least 1mt).

For those who do not comply with these provisions the accreditation will be revoked immediately.

GENERAL RULES (ITALIAN LAW)


In all areas of the rally it will be mandatory to wear the mask and maintain social distancing.

Only two people on board are allowed to travel by car (unless they are family members living together).


Always respect the 3 rules:

1. Wash your hands often with soap or disinfectant gel
2. Keep your mask on in all the rally zones (HQ, Service Park, regrouping, Media Zones).
3. Avoids creating assemblages
